Having cohabited for 13 years, and with two children, this couple decided on a tiny, family wedding and a party for friends afterwards. The design brief was "something paisley" with a joyful (rather than traditionally romantic) feel. Double-sided square 'postcard' invitation posted in matching purple envelopes. Cost: print of 100 invitations, envelopes: £230

Cost: design and print of 120 invitations, envelopes: £280 (£2.33 each card)

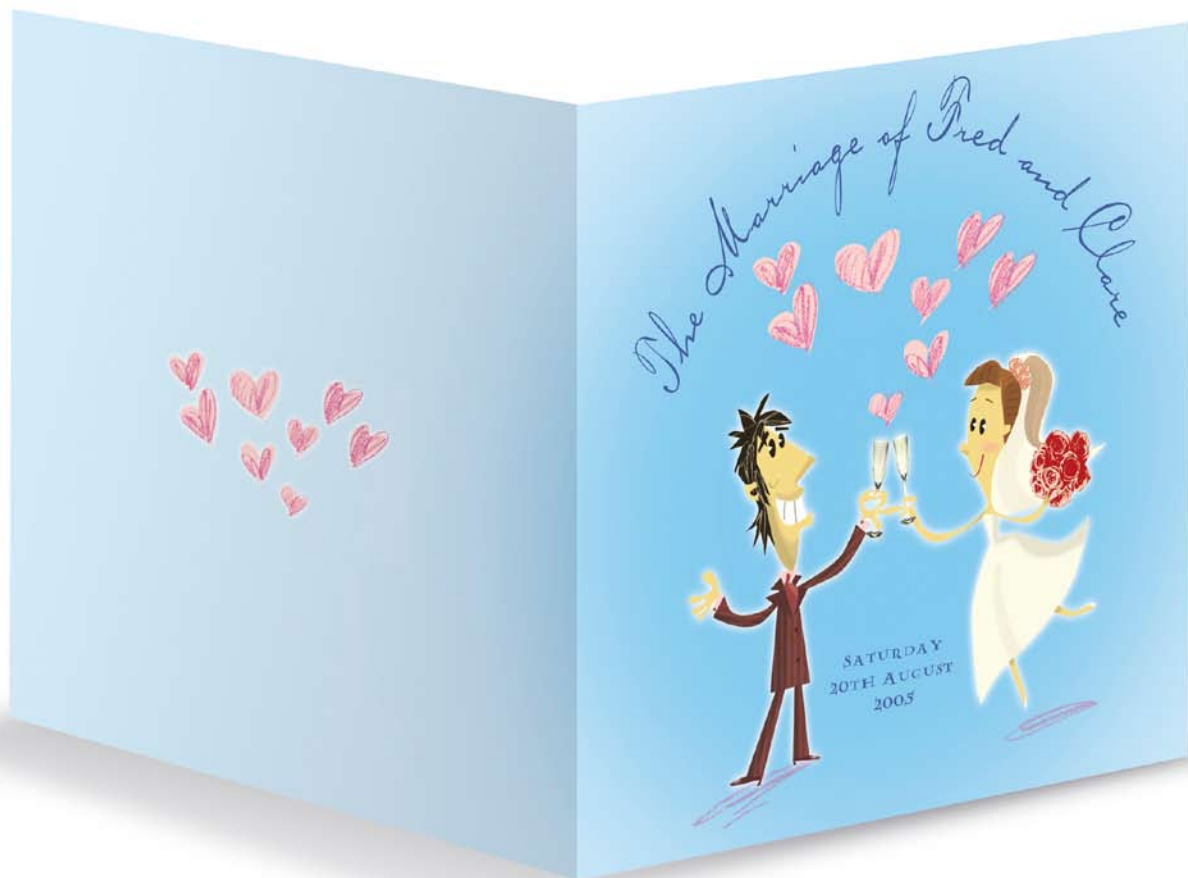
card front



This couple have a love of 50s and 60s music and style and asked for their invitations to be based on the album design of Blue Note records.

The monogram of their initials (A & P) on the front are repeated within the date on the reverse.

Double-sided square 'postcard' invitation posted in matching red envelopes.



Fred and Clare wanted something quirky – caricatures of the bride and groom.

Two sets of invitations with the same front and different insides were created for ceremony and reception guests.

Folded square card posted in white envelopes

Cost (including illustrations), print of 150 invitations, envelopes: £350 (£2.33 each card)

Janet and Geoff wanted their union of Scotland and England to be reflected in a traditional design.

England's white rose intertwines with the Scottish thistle – the design was inspired by the motif on the back of the old sixpenny piece.



Cost of design concept and intricate motif; print of 70 invitations and co-ordinating mauve envelopes: £300 (£4.20 each card)



Tony and Julie wanted a 'festival feel' to their outdoor blessing (with camping and bonfires) and invitations. I also created a website following this design theme. Double-sided square 'postcard' posted in sky blue envelopes.

Cost of design concept, print of 100 invitations and co-ordinating red envelopes: £240



Louisa and Dan's registry office wedding was followed by a champagne reception alongside a local river and an evening party. There was no brief for this invitation as such – this simple, romantic and 'natural' design hit the mark

A6 cards posted in blue envelopes:

Cost for 150 cards and envelopes £170 (£1.13 each)
